Pink—Paul the Venetian, Lord of the Third Ray: divine love and compassion


White—Serapis Bey, Lord of the Fourth Ray: purity and holiness


Green—Hilarion, Lord of the Fifth Ray: wholeness and abundance

The Role of the Blessed Maha Chohan


His title means the "Great Lord" and his mission is to focus the flame of the Holy Spirit on our behalf as the representative of the Holy Spirit for us.

- Ascended master tradition tells us he was able to convey comfort to life. His heart chakra and ability to emanate divine love were very developed




Devout Shepherd in India




P. 95 in *Spontaneous Evolution*: Quantum physics has named the concept of an invisible energy matrix, "the field."

Einstein called *the field* the "sole governing agency of matter." In other words, it is the universe's energy matrix that governs all matter.


He said, "There is no place in this new kind of physics both for the field and matter, for the field is the only reality."

The Dance of Shiva?

Pp. 104-106, Spontaneous Evolution:

"It isn't the density of matter that stops us from putting our hand through the wall; it's the density of energy! At the subatomic level, vortices [minitornadoes] of energy are constantly spinning and vibrating. ... You can't put your hand through a solid wall for the same reason you can't drive your car through a tornado."

Rupert Sheldrake, contemporary biologist, parapsychologist calls zero-point "a morphic field—a memory inherent in nature allowing instantaneous communication psychically." This explains to some degree why prayer works.

- Studies with AIDS patients and those recovering from surgical procedures proved that sending them healing intentions accelerated the healing process.
- Studies have shown "when the number of people practicing transcendental meditation reaches the square root of one percent of the population in a given city, the crime rate falls" dramatically.
- In the '90s a 24-hour prayer session using the science of invocation in New York City resulted in not one murder being reported to the police that day.
